On Saturday 22nd November 2008 Merseyside Police arrested thirteen people in Liverpool City Centre on suspicion of distributing written material, which may stir up racial hatred. The individuals arrested have been released on police bail while enquiries continue.

I am asking for support from all members of our community in remaining calm and helping Merseyside Police to ensure the safety and security of all individuals. Merseyside Police will take positive action in relation to any individual they believe are committing an unlawful act.
