In 1998 a million Australians took part in a national Sorry Day, when the Government refused to apologise for cruel past policies towards Aboriginal Australians. The National Sorry Day Committee then launched a Journey of Healing, which enlisted the Australian community in hundreds of initiatives aimed at exposing the tragic effect of these policies, and healing the harm done. Last year the new Australian Government made this long-awaited apology, and committed itself to a programme of action to transform the social conditions of Aboriginal Australia.

As Secretary of the National Sorry Day Committee from 1998 until 2006, John Bond was at the heart of this movement, and was awarded the Medal of the Order of Australia for his work.
